内容融洽度：学生续写内容与原文主题（谣言的影响及善意的重要性）高度契合，人物行为符合设定（“我”的愧疚与弥补、Del的孤独与包容），未出现矛盾或无关情节。“我”主动道歉、澄清谣言的行为，与原文“我”因谣言感到抱歉的心理一致；Del从被孤立到融入集体的转变，也符合其“孤独但善良”的特质，情节发展自然融洽。人物情感与行为逻辑一致，续写内容与原文主题、人物性格高度契合。

2. 篇章结构

篇章结构连贯性：第一段续写内容围绕“看到Del独自看比赛”展开，描述“我”的愧疚、解释谣言、Del接受道歉的过程，与段首句情节紧密衔接；第一段结尾“他微笑并握手”自然过渡到第二段“Del原谅我后决定做更多”的段首句。第二段续写内容基于“决定做更多”，具体展开澄清谣言、大家道歉、谣言停止、Del改变等情节，与段首句表述的“做更多”逻辑一致，整体情节发展连贯合理。

卷面分析

学生作答共计335字左右。卷面约有3处涂改痕迹，均为小区域涂改，如字母“w”“spe”“to”被涂抹。卷面整体较为工整整洁，但书写美观度和排版美观度仍有提升空间。建议在书写时注意字形的美观性，提前规划排版布局，以进一步提升卷面的整体效果。
