篇章结构连贯性：第一段续写内容直接响应"At recess the next day, I saw Del sitting alone watching the kickball game"的段首句，描述“我”向Del坦白的过程；第二段续写内容紧扣"Now that Del had forgiven me, I decided to do more before the recess was over"的段首句，展开“我”澄清谣言、邀请Del的行动，两段情节与段首句衔接合理，整体发展连贯。

3. 语法词汇 中

词汇语法多样性: 学生运用了“a strong wave of guilt bubbled up”“a wave of surprise flooded over his eyes”等生动的比喻和动态描写, 提升了文章可读性, 但核心词汇重复较多。通过比喻和连续动作描写丰富了场景刻画。可增加更多不同维度的词汇和句式, 避免核心词汇重复。

卷面分析

学生作答共计287字左右。卷面约有6处涂改痕迹，其中大范围涂改共3处，如所写的“sowwor”“sowwro”“advocate”被涂抹，小区域涂改共3处，如单词“swept”“were”“he”被涂抹。卷面整体表现良好，书写较为工整，卷面保持整洁，排版布局合理，整体视觉效果较为舒适。

语法分析

存在9类错误, 22个错误。包含代词错误(4个)、从句连接词错误(1个)、时态错误(3个)、名词错误(1个)、介词错误(6个)、语态错误(1个)、冠词错误(1个)、用词建议(2个)、动词形式错误(3个)

优秀表达

1. 【生动描写+复杂句型】A strong wave of guilt bubbled up from my heart,which reminded me its my rumor pushing him into darluness.
这句用“A strong wave of guilt bubbled up from my heart”生动地描绘出内心愧疚感的涌现，仿佛能让读者感受到你的情绪波动，非常形象；后面的

定语从句自然引出愧疚的原因，结构设计得很用心！不过有几处小细节可以改进：reminded me后需加that引导宾语从句，its应改为it was，darluness拼写错误，正确形式是darkness。

2. 【生动描写】I could see a sense of rage and disappointment sweep over his face.

这个表达太生动了！“sweep over his

face”精准地刻画了Del听到真相后，愤怒与失望的情绪在脸上蔓延的样子，让场景充满画面感，很棒！如果前面的“When the last word spoke”能调整为“When the last word left my mouth”会更地道哦。

3. 【生动描写】A wave of surprise flooded over his eyes,turning to tears welled up in it.

“A wave of surprise flooded over his eyes”生动地写出了Del收到邀请时的惊讶，仿佛能看到他眼中闪过的意外，很有感染力！不过有两个小问题：it应改为them（因为eyes是复数），“turning to tears welled up”可调整为“turning to tears welling up”（用现在分词作伴随状语更准确）。
