作文点评

综合点评

1. 内容

中

内容丰富度：学生通过“眼神从天真转为孤独”“埋头、流泪”等神态描写，“拉他、劝说、解释”等动作描写，以及“内心涌起幸福”的心理描写，展现了人物情绪变化；但环境细节（如操场氛围）、感官描写（如声音、触感）较少，整体细节类型不够多样，场景刻画稍显平淡。运用了神态、动作、心理等细节描写，体现了人物情绪和场景氛围。环境、感官等细节可更丰富，增强画面感。

内容完整度：学生续写围绕“道歉-弥补-化解谣言”的主线展开，从观察到Del的孤独、主动道歉，到“我”决定弥补并推动谣言解决，情节发展与原文“谣言传播-愧疚弥补”的核心线索形成闭环，主要情节无明显断层，整体有始有终。情节连贯性较好，实现了从误解到和解的完整过程。部分关键情节（如“我”如何具体劝说同学）展开稍显简略，可更丰富。

内容融洽度：学生续写内容与原文主题（谣言化解、友谊建立）和人物性格（“我”的愧疚、Del的敏感）高度契合，通过“道歉”“劝说”“解释”等情节自然延续了“我”的心理转变，Del从被误解到接受原谅的过程也符合其“被孤立后渴望友谊”的设定，无矛盾或偏离。人物情绪与情节发展贴合，情节衔接自然。“我”道歉时“结巴、颤抖”的细节可更细腻，增强真实感。

2. 篇章结构

中

篇章结构衔接性：学生作答通过“At recess the next day”承接段首句，用“After seeing his face filled with tear traces”“But I knew I should do more”等词句连接“道歉-接受原谅-决定行动”的情节，第二段以“Now that Del had forgive me”自然过渡到“我”的行动，整体情节衔接流畅，故事脉络清晰。

篇章结构连贯性：第一段续写内容围绕“看到Del独自看比赛”展开，描述Del的状态、“我”的道歉及Del的原谅，与段首句情节紧密衔接；第一段结尾“我应该做更多”为第二段“决定做更多”做铺垫，第二段续写内容紧扣“决定做更多”展开，描述“我”拉Del、解释谣言、邀请游戏等行动，与段首句逻辑连贯。整体情节发展与两个续写段首句表述的内容前后呼应，合理连贯。

3. 语法词汇

中

词汇语法准确性：学生续写内容中存在代词错误、介词错误、时态错误等语法问题，但整体不影响对情节的理解。大部分句子结构完整，能清晰传递情节发展。部分语法错误如代词使用不当、时态不一致等需注意修正。

词汇语法恰当性：学生使用了“stampered to apologize”“flash of anger”“unfriendly sight”等贴合情境的词汇，但“pull him out”“with nervousness”等表述稍显生硬。多数词汇能准确反映人物情绪和场景变化。个别短语与前后文衔接可更自然。

词汇语法多样性：学生运用了“flash of anger”“attitude turned to compassionate”等生动表达，但句式以简单句为主，核心词汇如“apologize”“forgive”重复较多。部分短语能通过细节描写增强画面感。可尝试使用更多样的句式和词汇避免重复。

卷面分析

学生作答共计290字左右。卷面约有1处涂改痕迹，为小区域涂改，如单词“then”被涂抹。卷面整体表现优秀，书写工整美观，排版规范有序，整体整洁度高，呈现出良好的书写习惯。

语法分析

存在8类错误，23个错误。包含代词错误（2个）、动词形式错误（4个）、介词错误（5个）、时态错误（6个）、助动词错误（1个）、用词建议（3个）、冠词错误（1个）、情态动词错误（1个）
