作文点评

综合点评

1. 内容

中

内容丰富度：学生续写包含神态（“great sorrow clouded his eyes”）、心理（“shame and anxiety crowded in my mind”）、动作（“walked slowly to Del”“told the players the truth”）、环境（“sunlight gathered at the rim of the retreating clouds”）等细节描写，生动展现了人物情绪和场景画面，结尾通过“友谊的价值”“反思谣言”实现主旨升华，内容较丰富。

内容完整度：学生续写围绕“谣言澄清-道歉与和解”主线展开，第一段承接段首句描述“我”向Del坦白的过程，第二段承接段首句描述澄清后的行动及结果，实现了从误解到澄清的闭环，核心线索自然延展，情节发展无明显断层。

内容融洽度：学生续写内容与原文主题（谣言的影响、误解的澄清）和人物性格（“我”的愧疚、Del的包容）高度契合，通过“我”的道歉、Del的宽容、孩子们的接纳等情节，构建了与原文发展融洽的故事脉络，无矛盾或无关情节。

2. 篇章结构

中

篇章结构衔接性：学生作答通过“Seeing this”连接“我”的羞愧与不敢接近Del的心理活动，用“Ultimately”引出“我”的行动转折，第二段用“With the misunderstanding cleared up”衔接澄清后的结果，整体情节发展有一定衔接，但“rushed to the kickball game court”与前文“坐在球场旁”的场景转换稍显突兀，部分情节过渡不够自然。

篇章结构连贯性：第一段续写内容围绕“看到Del独自看比赛”展开，描述“我”的心理变化与主动坦白，与第一个续写段首句情节连贯；第二段续写内容以“Del原谅后决定做更多”为起点，讲述澄清误会、玩家反应及Del道歉，与第二个续写段首句情节衔接合理。整体情节发展符合原文逻辑，前后文连贯。

3. 语法词汇

中

词汇语法准确性：学生续写内容中存在形容词副词错误、从句连接词错误、动词形式错误等语法问题，但整体不影响阅读理解。大部分句子结构完整，核心语义清晰。部分语法细节需注意，如形容词副词的正确使用和动词形式的准确性。

词汇语法恰当性：学生使用了“a great sorrow clouded his eyes”“rushed to”“invited to play”等贴合情景的词汇短语，但“as to think why we isolated him”“felt sorry about him”等表述稍显生硬或搭配不够自然。多数词汇能准确传递人物情感和情节发展。个别短语搭配需更贴近日常表达习惯。

词汇语法多样性：学生运用了“a burst of shame and anxiety crowded in my mind”等生动意象描写，以及“sunlight... spilled like silk”的环境描写，还使用了倒装句式丰富表达，但核心词汇如“del”“recess”重复较多。通过环境描写和倒装句式提升了文章可读性。可适当增加人物对话或心理描写的多样性表达。

卷面分析

学生作答共计244字左右。卷面约有6处涂改痕迹，其中大范围涂改共2处，如所写的“sat at”“welleino”被涂抹，小区域涂改共4处，如单词“even”“I”被涂抹。卷面整体表现良好，书写工整美观，卷面较为整洁，整体呈现出较好的规范性；若能在排版布局上进一步优化，效果会更理想。

语法分析

存在10类错误，17个错误。包含形容词副词错误（3个）、从句连接词错误（1个）、动词形式错误（2个）、代词错误（1个）、句子成分残缺（1个）、用词建议（2个）、介词错误（4个）、句式表达建议（1个）、时态错误（1个）、冠词错误（1个）
