作文点评

综合点评

1. 内容

中

内容丰富度：学生通过“sense of chame（愧疚）”“slender back view（瘦背影）”“sadness in his eyes（眼中的悲伤）”等细节描写，展现了“我”的心理活动和Del的情绪状态；“called my friends together”“送卡片和花”等动作描写增强了场景画面感。但部分细节（如“remakeable（可修复的）”表述）稍显生硬，整体细节描写可更细腻。运用了心理、动作等细节描写，人物情绪和场景画面感得以体现。部分情节（如“remakeable”）表述不够自然，细节丰富度可进一步提升。

内容完整度：学生续写围绕“谣言澄清-弥补过错”的主线展开，从“我”主动道歉到召集朋友弥补，情节发展与原文误解、愧疚的核心线索形成闭环，主要情节（道歉、澄清、弥补）有始有终，无明显断层或冗余。情节连贯自然，实现了从谣言传播到澄清弥补的完整故事脉络。

内容融洽度：学生续写内容与原文主题（谣言的影响与反思）、人物性格（“我”的愧疚、Del的宽容）高度契合，未出现矛盾或无情节。Del的原谅、“我”的主动弥补等情节，符合原文中“我”从误解到愧疚的情感转变逻辑。

2. 篇章结构

中

篇章结构衔接性：学生作答通过"Seeing his slender back view"承接段首句对Del的观察，用"I screwed up my courage and went towards him"自然引出道歉行为；第二段以"Now that Del had forgiven me"承接上段结尾，用"called my friends together"衔接弥补行动，情节发展前后衔接流畅。

篇章结构连贯性：第一段续写内容直接围绕段首句"看到Del独自看踢足球比赛"展开，描述"我"的愧疚与道歉，与段首句情节连贯；第二段续写内容以"决定做更多"承接段首句，具体展开"我"的行动（告知真相、送礼物），与段首句情节衔接合理。整体情节发展逻辑清晰，前后文连贯。

3. 语法词汇

中

词汇语法准确性：学生续写内容中存在介词错误、动词形式错误、主谓不一致等语法问题，但整体不影响阅读理解。大部分句子结构完整，能清晰传递情节和情感。部分细节如“spilt”“remakeable”等需注意规范使用。

词汇语法恰当性：学生使用了“screwed up my courage”“lowered my head”等贴合情境的表达，但“remakeable”“with thankfulness in his eyes”等表述稍显生硬或与语境契合度不足。核心情节相关词汇能准确传递人物互动。个别短语可结合具体场景选择更贴切的表达。

词汇语法多样性：学生运用了“sense of shame rose”“the sadness in his eyes could even spilt out”等生动描写，以及谚语引用提升可读性，但句式以简单句为主，核心词汇重复使用。通过细节描写和谚语引用为文章增添了感染力。可尝试使用更多样的句式结构丰富表达。

卷面分析

学生作答共计233字左右。卷面约有5处涂改痕迹，其中大范围涂改共1处，如所写的“senecercly”被涂抹，小区域涂改共4处，如单词“a”“tha”“w a”等被涂抹。卷面整体表现良好，书写工整美观，排版规范有序，整体视觉效果较为舒适。

语法分析

存在7类错误，12个错误。包含时态错误（2个）、介词错误（1个）、动词形式错误（2个）、用词建议（2个）、主谓不一致（2个）、词性错误（2个）、代词错误（1个）
