作文点评

综合点评

1. 内容

中

内容丰富度：学生通过“喉咙发紧”“低头盯着手”“眼睛上扬、困惑”等神态细节，“拉他的手”“解释并道歉”等动作细节，以及“云散阳光洒下”的环境描写，生动展现了人物情绪变化和场景画面感；结尾“领悟到不要传播偏见、不要以自我为中心对待他人”的主旨升华，进一步丰富了内容，人物和场景刻画细腻，有感染力。

内容完整度：学生续写围绕“误解-道歉-和解-反思”的主线展开，从Jamie主动向Del坦白谣言的真相，到两人关系缓和，再到Jamie带领Del融入群体并领悟道理，情节发展与原文和续写段首句形成闭环，核心线索自然延展且逻辑合理，无明显断层或冗余，整体有始有终。

内容融洽度：学生续写内容与原文主题（谣言的危害、误解的化解）和人物性格（Jamie从偏见到愧疚、Del的委屈与包容）高度契合，情节发展（Jamie主动坦白、带Del融入群体）环环相扣，无无关或矛盾情节，与原文故事发展融洽自然。

2. 篇章结构

篇章结构衔接性：学生作答通过"Urged by shame"（被羞愧驱使）、"His eyebrows were lifted, looked confused"（Del的困惑反应）、"I took a deep breath and continued"（"我"坦白的连贯动作）、"Suddenly"（转折情绪）、"Now that Del had forgiven me"（承接上文结果）、"I pulled up his hand"（主动行动）、"gathering Del into the crowd"（群体互动）、"as time parsing by"（时间推移）、"After the recess"（课后时间）等衔接词句，自然连接了"我"道歉、Del反应、带Del融入群体、同学态度转变、课后对话等情节，故事脉络流畅清晰。

篇章结构连贯性：第一段续写内容直接响应"第二天课间看到Del独自看踢足球比赛"的段首句，通过"我"主动道歉、坦白真相的情节，与前文"我"传播谣言的愧疚形成连贯衔接；第二段续写内容以"Del原谅我后决定做更多"为起点，展开带Del融入群体、同学理解、课后道歉等情节，与段首句"做更多"的表述紧密呼应。两段续写内容与原文段首句构建的前后文逻辑合理，情节发展自然连贯。

3. 语法词汇

中

词汇语法准确性：学生续写内容中存在介词错误、时态错误、代词错误等语法问题，但整体不影响阅读理解。大部分句子结构完整，核心语义清晰。部分小错误如介词使用不当、时态不一致等需注意修正。

词汇语法恰当性：学生使用了"urged by shame"、"throat tightened"、"gathering Del into the crowd"等贴合情境的词汇短语，但"pulled up his hand"、"for other understandable reasons"等表述稍显生硬。多数词汇能准确传递主角的心理变化和行为意图。个别短语搭配不够自然，需更贴合日常表达习惯。

词汇语法多样性：学生运用了"throat tightened"、"my heart sank deeply"、"gathering Del into the crowd"等生动短语，以及环境描写句式丰富文章，但核心词汇如"recess"重复较多。通过具体动作和场景描写提升了文章画面感。可增加更多不同句式和词汇避免重复。

卷面分析

学生作答共计278字左右。卷面约有4处涂改痕迹，其中大范围涂改共2处，如所写的“Afther”“threal”被涂抹，小区域涂改共2处，如“th”“wor”被涂抹。卷面整体较为工整整洁，但书写美观度和排版美观度仍有提升空间。建议在书写时注意字形的美观性，提前规划排版布局，以进一步提升卷面的整体效果。

语法分析

存在7类错误，11个错误。包含介词错误（2个）、句子成分残缺（1个）、时态错误（3个）、动词错误（2个）、代词错误（1个）、名词错误（1个）、用词建议（1个）
