作文点评

综合点评

1. 内容

中

内容丰富度：学生续写包含心理（愧疚、羞愧）、动作（上前道歉、邀请加入）、神态（眼睛 sparkled with excitement）等细节描写，展现了“我”的情绪变化和Del的善意，结尾“意识到消除偏见的重要性”实现了主旨升华。通过“心跳剧烈”“脸红”等细节刻画“我”的紧张与羞愧，用“眼睛 sparkled with excitement”表现Del的兴奋，增强了场景画面感和人物感染力。环境（如踢足球时的氛围）、感官（如笑声、阳光）等细节描写较少，可进一步丰富场景细节，使故事更生动。

内容完整度：学生续写围绕“道歉-澄清-弥补”的主线展开，从“我”看到Del被孤立的愧疚，到主动道歉被原谅，再到向同学澄清并邀请Del参与活动，情节发展与原文谣言澄清的核心线索形成闭环，主要情节连贯无断层，整体有始有终。情节紧扣原文矛盾（谣言与真相），通过“道歉-澄清-弥补”的递进发展，实现了故事的完整闭环。第二段“做更多”的具体行动（澄清、邀请）可更详细展开，如补充“我”如何组织同学、Del的具体反应等，使情节更充实。

内容融洽度：学生续写内容与原文主题（反思偏见、传递善意）高度契合，人物行为（“我”的愧疚与弥补、Del的宽容）符合原文设定（“我”的反思者角色、Del的善良形象），未出现矛盾或无关情节，续写情节自然融入原文故事脉络。人物情绪（“我”的愧疚、Del的宽容）与原文“我”的反思心理一致，情节发展环环相扣，无突兀或偏离。“Del几乎 instantly forgave me”的表述稍显简略，可补充“我”道歉时的具体对话或Del的反应细节，增强情节真实感。

2. 篇章结构

篇章结构衔接性：学生作答通过"Being filled with deep loss"承接Del的失落情绪，"Then I made up my mind"引出道歉行为，"To my surprise"体现Del的宽容，"Now that Del had forgiven me"自然过渡到"我"的补救行动，"Thinking of Del's kind face"衔接"我"的心理活动，"Picking up the kickball"连接邀请Del的动作，情节发展通过这些衔接词句流畅串联，前后文衔接自然。

篇章结构连贯性：第一段续写内容直接响应"At recess the next day, I saw Del sitting alone watching the kickball game"的段首句，描述"我"看到Del后的心理活动与行动；第二段续写内容以"Now that Del had forgiven me, I decided to do more before the recess was over"为起点，展开"我"向同学澄清、邀请Del的补救行为，两段内容与各自段首句紧密衔接，且第一段结尾Del的原谅自然过渡到第二段"我"的补救行动，整体情节发展连贯合理。

3. 语法词汇

中

词汇语法准确性：学生续写内容中存在介词错误、冠词错误、时态错误、动词形式错误等问题，但整体不影响文章阅读理解。大部分句子结构完整，核心语义清晰。部分语法细节需注意，如介词搭配和动词时态的准确性。

词汇语法恰当性：学生使用了"filled with deep loss"、"a strong sense of guilt"、"regret in their eyes"等词汇短语，与主角愧疚、弥补过错的情景高度契合；仅个别表述如"forgave me almost instantly"稍显生硬。大部分词汇能准确传递人物情感和情节发展。个别短语搭配可更自然。

词汇语法多样性：学生运用了分词结构、倒装句式等丰富句式，以及"heart beating violently"、"eyes sparkled with excitement"等生动描写，提升了文章可读性；但核心词汇如"del"重复较多。句式和描写手法有一定变化，增强了文章表现力。部分核心词汇重复使用，可适当增加同义替换。

卷面分析

学生作答共计217字左右。卷面约有5处涂改痕迹，均为小区域涂改，如单词“the”“his”“make”等被涂抹。卷面整体表现良好，书写较为工整，卷面保持整洁，排版布局合理，整体视觉效果较为舒适。

语法分析

存在4类错误，6个错误。包含介词错误（2个）、系动词错误（1个）、时态错误（1个）、动词形式错误（2个）

优秀表达
