2. 【生动描写】The softwind blew over us .
这句通过描写柔和的风拂过的场景，生动烘托出你和Del之间气氛的缓和，很有画面感，属于优秀的生动描写！不过要注意拼写细节，softwind应该分开写成soft wind哦~
3. 【复杂句型】It is me that make you be excluded by others
你尝试用强调句（It is ... that ...）来突出自己的错误，句型运用的意识非常好，值得鼓励！不过有几个小改进点：1. 事情发生在过去，make要改成made；2. make的用法是make sb done，所以“make you be excluded”可简化为“make you excluded”；3. 强调主语时用I（主格）更规范，正确表达可改为“It was I who made you excluded by others”。继续加油，你的句型运用会越来越熟练的！
