作文点评

综合点评

1. 内容

中

内容丰富度：学生通过“guilty”“nervous, my heart beat violently and my palms were sweating”等心理描写，“walked to Del”“yelled”等动作描写，以及“warm smile”“face burying”等神态细节，生动刻画了“我”的愧疚与Del的宽容，场景画面感强，人物情绪传递到位，结尾“this experience dawned on me”的主旨升华更增强了感染力。细节描写充分，心理、动作、神态等多维度刻画细腻，有效提升了故事的感染力和深度。

内容完整度：学生续写围绕“道歉-弥补”主线展开，从“我”主动向Del道歉解释谣言，到“我”公开道歉并带动Del行动，最终以“我”的领悟收尾，实现了与原文误解、愧疚、弥补的闭环，情节发展连贯无断层，整体有始有终。情节紧扣段首句和原文核心线索，从个人到集体的道歉逻辑清晰，主线完整。

内容融洽度：学生续写内容与原文主题（谣言与误解的化解）、人物性格（“我”的愧疚、Del的宽容）高度契合，未出现矛盾或无关情节。“我”因偏见误解他人后主动弥补，Del从被孤立到被理解的转变，均符合原文铺垫的发展逻辑，情节自然融洽。

2. 篇章结构

篇章结构衔接性：学生作答通过"ashamed and self-blamed（感到羞愧并自责）""guilty（内疚）""nervous（紧张）""started to explain（开始解释）"等心理和动作描述，自然衔接了"我"从看到Del到主动道歉的过程；第二段用"made a bold decision（做出大胆决定）""stroied to the centre（大步走向中心）""yelled（大喊）""Finishing this talk（完成讲述后）"等动作和状态变化，连贯呈现了"我"从决定弥补到公开道歉、Del回应的情节发展，整体衔接流畅。

篇章结构连贯性：第一段续写内容直接响应了第一个续写段首句"第二天课间看到Del独自看踢足球比赛"的情节，通过"我"主动走向Del并解释误会，自然过渡到第二段"Del原谅我"的段首句；第二段续写内容围绕"我"在课间结束前做更多（公开道歉）展开，与第二个续写段首句紧密衔接。两段之间，第一段结尾Del表示"不知道玩笑伤害了你"为第二段"我"决定公开道歉做了合理铺垫，整体情节发展连贯合理。

3. 语法词汇

中

词汇语法准确性：学生续写内容中存在词性错误、动词形式错误、时态错误等语法问题，但整体不影响阅读理解。大部分句子结构完整，核心语义清晰。部分语法问题如词性误用、动词形式错误需注意修正。

词汇语法恰当性：学生使用了"Ashamed and self-blamed""nervous""patted on my shoulder with a warm smile"等贴合情境的词汇短语，但"with guilty""I have a prejudice against you"等表述稍显生硬。多数词汇能准确传递人物情感与情节发展。个别短语搭配需更贴合日常表达习惯。

词汇语法多样性：学生运用了"my heart beat violently and my palms were sweating"等细节描写短语，以及"the whole school clapped after Del apolo gized"等场景描写句式，但整体以简单句式为主，核心词汇如"apologize"重复使用。通过细节描写和场景刻画丰富了文章表达。可尝试使用更多样的句式结构避免重复。

卷面分析

学生作答共计273字左右。卷面约有7处涂改痕迹，其中大范围涂改共3处，如所写的“apologed”“others”被涂抹，小区域涂改共4处，如单词“the”“to”被涂抹。卷面整体表现优秀，书写工整美观，排版规范有序，整体整洁度高，展现出良好的书写习惯。

语法分析

存在7类错误，16个错误。包含词性错误（1个）、动词形式错误（4个）、时态错误（4个）、介词错误（4个）、系动词错误（1个）、代词错误（1个）、从句连接词错误（1个）

优秀表达

这个句子通过“heart beat violently”和“palms were sweating”这些具体的生理细节，生动形象地刻画出你当时紧张的心理状态，让读者能够直观地感受到你的情绪，是非常棒的生动描写哦！

2. 【地道短语搭配】This experience dawned on me that we should never have a bias against others, which may hurt others deeply. 你使用了“dawned on me”这个地道的短语来表达“使我明白”，精准传达了经历后的感悟；后面的定语从句也自然补充了偏见的危害，值得肯定。不过有个小结构问题：“dawned on me”的正确用法是“It dawned on me that...”（需形式主语It），改成“It dawned on me that we should never have a bias against others...”会更符合英语表达习惯哦！

开头用“Ashamed and self-blamed”作伴随状语，生动表现出你愧疚自责的心情，很有感染力。不过有几个小语法点可改进：“with guilty”改为“with guilt”（介词后接名词），“thought”改为“thinking”（现在分词作伴随），“owe”改为“owed”（时态一致），这样句子会更准确流畅哦！
