作文点评

综合点评

1. 内容 好

内容丰富度：学生通过“guiltiness（愧疚）”“heart beating fast（心跳加速）”“lowering head and cheeks burning with shame（低头、脸颊发烫）”等心理与神态描写，细腻展现了“我”的愧疚；通过“grabbed his hand”“explained the whole process”等动作描写，刻画了“我”的主动与真诚；通过队友“eyes were filled with hatred（眼中充满仇恨）”到“astonished and regretness（惊讶与后悔）”的情绪变化，丰富了场景细节。细节描写充分，人物情绪与场景画面感突出，增强了故事的感染力。

内容完整度：学生续写围绕“道歉-澄清-弥补”的主线展开，从“我”因谣言愧疚主动道歉，到带Del找队友澄清，再到队友道歉并“我”反思，情节发展与原文谣言传播、误解澄清的核心线索形成闭环，逻辑连贯无断层，实现了故事的完整收尾。情节紧扣原文矛盾，从误解到澄清再到反思，主线清晰且有始有终。

内容融洽度：学生续写内容与原文主题（谣言的危害、误解的澄清）高度契合，人物行为符合设定（“我”的愧疚与弥补、Del的宽容），未出现矛盾或无关情节。Del对“我”的宽容、队友从误解到道歉的转变，均自然承接原文中Del的孤独与“我”的反思，情节发展环环相扣。人物性格与原文一致，情节发展贴合故事背景，无突兀或偏离。

2. 篇章结构 好

篇章结构衔接性：学生作答通过"Realizing that my irresponsible rumor had led to this situation"衔接段首句的"看到Del独自看比赛"与"我"的愧疚情绪，用"Then I explained the whole thing"连接道歉与解释行为，第二段以"grabbed his hand and took him to the kickball players"承接"做更多"的决定，情节发展通过心理活动（愧疚感）、动作（道歉、解释）自然串联，前后衔接流畅。

篇章结构连贯性：第一段续写内容直接响应"At recess the next day, I saw Del sitting alone watching the kickball game"的段首句，描述"我看到Del后的心理变化与行动；第一段结尾"意识到长久误解Del"自然过渡到第二段"Del原谅后决定做更多"的段首句。第二段续写内容围绕"做更多"展开，通过带Del找孩子们解释、孩子们道歉等情节，完整落实段首句的"决定"，整体情节发展与两个段首句衔接合理连贯。

卷面分析

学生作答共计292字左右。卷面约有7处涂改痕迹，其中大范围涂改共1处，如所写的“ca everyone”被涂抹，小区域涂改共6处，如单词“What”“ape s”等被涂抹。卷面整体表现良好，书写较为工整，卷面保持整洁，排版布局合理，整体视觉效果较为舒适。
