作文点评

综合点评

1. 内容

中

内容丰富度：学生续写包含心理描写（“我”的愧疚、“我”的释然）、动作描写（靠近Del、写道歉信）、神态描写（Del的困惑、生气）等细节，还通过“内心像大石头落地”等表述传递情感，结尾升华主旨（不传播谣言）。但部分细节（如“写道歉信”的过程、“跑向踢足球同学”的具体对话）描写较概括，人物和场景刻画可更细腻。

内容完整度：学生续写围绕“澄清谣言-弥补过错”的主线展开，从“我”主动道歉到后续弥补行为（靠近Del、写道歉信、解释谣言），实现了与原文“传播谣言-愧疚弥补”情节的闭环，核心线索自然延展，主要情节无明显断层，整体有始有终。情节发展连贯，从误解到澄清再到弥补，完整呈现了故事的解决过程。第二段“do more”的具体行动（如靠近Del、写道歉信）可适当补充细节，使弥补行为更生动。

内容融洽度：学生续写内容与原文主题（谣言的危害、真诚道歉）和人物性格（“我”的愧疚、Del的包容）高度契合，未出现矛盾情节。“我”主动道歉、Del从生气到原谅、“我”进一步弥补的行为，均符合原文中“我”因误解产生愧疚的逻辑，情节发展自然合理。Del原谅的过程稍显简略，可增加更多互动细节（如Del的表情变化、“我”的安抚话语）增强真实感。

2. 篇章结构

篇章结构衔接性：学生作答通过"so I approached Del and sitted beside him（所以我就走近Del并坐在他旁边）"、"Then I explained the whole story and made a genuine apology（然后我解释了整个故事并真诚道歉）"、"The most critical thing I needed to do is explain the rumor（我需要做最重要的事是解释谣言）"等衔接词句，自然连接了观察到Del情绪、主动沟通、解释谣言、采取行动等情节，故事发展脉络清晰流畅。

篇章结构连贯性：第一段续写内容直接承接"At recess the next day, I saw Del sitting alone watching the kickball game"的段首句，详细展开“我”与Del的互动过程，情节衔接紧密；第二段续写内容以"Now that Del had forgiven me, I decided to do more before the recess was over"为起点，明确“我”的具体行动（解释谣言），与第一段结尾Del原谅的情节自然过渡，整体与两个续写段首句的情节发展连贯合理。

3. 语法词汇

中

词汇语法准确性：学生续写内容中存在时态错误、动词形式错误、书写不规范等问题，如“It's”“sitted”“sticked”等，一定程度上影响了部分语句的流畅理解，但整体仍能传达核心情节。大部分句子结构完整，能清晰表达事件发展和人物情感。需注意动词时态和形式的正确使用，避免因小错误影响语句连贯性。

词汇语法恰当性：学生使用了“overwhelmed by a blend of disappointment and confusion”“made up my mind to clarify my fault”等贴合情境的表达，但“comfront me”“exchaining”等表述与语境存在脱节或使用不够准确的问题。多数词汇能围绕“澄清谣言”“修复关系”的核心情节展开，符合上下文逻辑。个别短语需调整以更准确传达意图，如“comfront”可改为“confront”。

词汇语法多样性：学生运用了“overwhelmed by a blend of disappointment and confusion”“the big heavy stone in my heart had fallen down”等较生动的表达，但句式以简单句为主，核心词汇如“kickball”“apology”重复较多，缺乏复杂句式的变化。部分短语和比喻为文章增添了画面感和情感深度。可尝试使用更多样的句式结构，避免核心词汇重复。

卷面分析

学生作答共计230字左右。卷面约有6处涂改痕迹，多为小区域涂改，如单词“that”“run”“The”等被涂抹。卷面整体表现较为一般，书写和排版的工整美观度有待提升，但卷面整洁度尚可。建议在书写前理清思路，减少随意涂改，注意书写的规范性和排版的合理性，以提升整体卷面效果。

语法分析
