作文点评

综合点评

1. 内容

内容丰富度：学生通过“腿放胸前、眼睛悲伤”的神态描写，“内疚感加重”的心理刻画，“跑去操场、大声喊叫”的动作细节，以及“脸变亮、冲过去打球”的神态变化，生动展现了人物情绪与场景画面感；结尾“善意修复隔阂”的主旨升华，进一步丰富了内容，人物和场景刻画细腻，有感染力。

内容完整度：学生续写围绕“谣言澄清-修复友谊”主线展开，从“我”主动道歉、Del表达孤立的难过，到“我”澄清弟弟真相、男孩们接纳Del，情节发展与原文误解、愧疚形成闭环，核心线索自然延展，无明显断层或冗余，整体有始有终。

内容融洽度：学生续写内容与原文主题（谣言与误解）、人物性格（“我”的愧疚、Del的孤独）高度契合，通过“道歉-澄清-和解”情节，合理承接了“我”从误解到愧疚的心理变化，未出现矛盾或无关情节，续写与原文发展融洽自然。

2. 篇章结构

篇章结构衔接性：学生作答通过"Taking a deep breath"、"At the moment"、"After a moment"等衔接词句，自然连接了"我"从内疚到坦白、从澄清到行动的情节发展，故事脉络流畅清晰。

篇章结构连贯性：第一段续写内容直接承接"第二天课间看到Del独自看比赛"的段首句，展开"我"主动道歉的情节；第二段续写内容以"Del原谅我"为起点，自然延伸出"我"澄清谣言、邀请踢球的行动，两段均与对应段首句紧密衔接，情节发展逻辑合理。

3. 语法词汇

词汇语法准确性：学生续写内容中存在时态错误、动词形式错误、介词错误等问题，但整体不影响阅读理解。大部分句子结构完整，能清晰传递情节和情感。需注意时态一致性和动词搭配的准确性，如“is”可调整为“was”，“cried”可调整为“crying”等。

词汇语法恰当性：学生使用了“legs were put on his chest”“the guilt in my chest grew heavier”“face lit up”等贴合情境的表达，但部分表述如“made that rumor”“made up for the mistakes”稍显笼统或搭配生硬。大部分词汇能准确反映人物情绪和情节发展。个别短语可进一步具体化，如明确“我”编造谣言的指向。

词汇语法多样性：学生运用了“Taking a deep breath”“face lit up”等细节描写短语，以及“the kindness between us that have the power to fix up the gap”的总结句，但整体以简单句式为主，核心词汇如“recess”“Del”重复较多。通过动作和情绪描写短语丰富了场景细节。可尝试使用更多样的句式结构，避免核心词汇重复。

卷面分析

学生作答共计253字左右。卷面约有9处涂改痕迹，其中大范围涂改共1处，如所写的“said with”被涂抹，小区域涂改共8处，如“the”“mick”等被涂抹。卷面整体表现良好，书写较为工整，排版整齐规范，整体较为整洁，虽书写美观度稍显不足，但整体仍体现出较好的书写习惯。

语法分析

存在7类错误，17个错误。包含动词形式错误（3个）、时态错误（5个）、用词建议（1个）、介词错误（4个）、动词错误（1个）、句子成分残缺（2个）、冠词错误（1个）
