【时态错误】arrive → arrived

【名词错误】cloud → clouds

【纠错依据】原句中使用了动词原形"arrive", 但句子描述的是过去发生的事情, 应该使用过去式"arrived"来表示过去的时间。原句中"cloud"使用了单数形式, 但根据上下文, 应该是指多片云, 故应使用复数形式"clouds"来表示多个云。

3. The sun ~~leaved~~ **let out** some ~~briliant~~ **brilliant** rays as it ~~illuminating~~ **illuminated** the ~~cow~~ **cows** that were wandering around the farm lazily with their tails flicking.

【动词错误,书写不规范】leaved → let out

【动词形式错误】illuminating → illuminated

【名词错误】cow → cows

【纠错依据】原句中使用了"leaved", 这是动词"leave"的过去式, 但在此处不符合语境。正确的表达应为短语动词"let out", 表示"释放"或"发出", 更贴切地描述太阳发出光芒的情景。原句中"illuminating"是现在分词形式, 但此处需要过去式"illuminated", 与前面的"let out"保持时态一致, 表示过去发生的动作。原句中"cow"为单数形式, 但后面的"that were wandering"中的"were"表明主语应为复数形式。因此, 将"cow"改为复数形式"cows", 以保持主谓一致。

【纠错依据】动词"start"应使用过去式"started", 以符合叙述过去发生的动作。在"gently"后应使用现在分词"running", 构成现在分词短语, 修饰主语"The wind", 表示风正在轻柔地穿过风车叶片。动词"pushed"应改为现在分词"pushing", 与前面的"started"和"running"保持形式一致, 构成并列的现在分词短语, 表示风正在推动风车转动。在"pushing it"后应使用不定式"to turn", 表示目的, 说明推动风车是为了让它转动。动词"creaked"应改为动词原形"creak", 与前面的"to turn"保持形式一致, 构成并列的不定式短语, 表示风车转动并发出吱吱声。

【动词错误】on → up

【纠错依据】原句中"stood on"的用法不正确, "stand up"是固定短语, 表示"站起来", 因此应将"on"改为"up"。

【动词错误】cut → out

【纠错依据】原句中"pulled cut"是错误的动词搭配, 正确的表达应为"pulled out", 表示"拿出"的意思。"pull out"是固定短语, 表示从某处拉出或取出。

7. He had found the beauty of this ~~bore~~ **boring** town.

【词性错误】bore → boring

【纠错依据】原句中使用了形容词"bore", 但"bore"是动词"bear"的过去式, 意思是"忍受", 在这里不符合语境。应使用现在分词"boring", 表示"令人感到无聊的", 用来修饰名词"town", 表达"这个令人感到无聊的小镇"的意思。因此, 将"bore"改为"boring"更为恰当。

8. Everyone was curious about the winner and ~~discussed~~ **discussing** with their friends.

【动词形式错误】discussed → discussing

【纠错依据】原句中使用了过去式"discussed", 但根据上下文, 描述的是当时正在发生的事情, 应该使用现在分词"discussing"来表示动作正在进行。这样, "discussing with their friends"与前面的"was curious about the winner"构成并列结构, 表示大家既对获奖者感到好奇, 又正在与朋友讨论。

9. The soft light fell upon the people, it ~~lighted~~ **lit** the paintings that ~~was~~ **were** about to ~~apprais~~ **be appraised**.

【用词建议】lighted → lit

【主谓不一致】was → were

【动词形式错误】apprais → be appraised

【纠错依据】原句中使用逗号连接两个独立的句子, 这是不正确的。应在逗号后添加连词"and", 以正确连接两个并列的句子, 使句子结构完整。动词"light"的过去式是"lit", 而不是"lighted"。在正式写作中, 使用"lit"更为简洁和规范。先行词"the paintings"是复数形式, 关系从句中的谓语动词应与之保持一致, 因此"was"应改为"were"。原句中"apprais"缺少被动语态的助动词"be", 应为"be appraised"。此外, "appraise"是及物动词, 需有宾语, 但此处没有宾语, 因此使用被动语态"be appraised"更为恰当。

【用词建议,语态错误】turned out → was announced

【时态错误】jump → jumped

【纠错依据】原句中使用了短语"turned out", 但在此处不符合语境。"Turn out"通常表示"结果是"或"证明是", 而这里需要表达的是"名字被宣布"的意思。正确的表达应为"was announced", 表示"名字被宣布", 更符合英语习惯用法。句子描述的是过去发生的事情, 动词应使用过去式。原句中的"jump"应改为过去式"jumped", 以保持时态一致, 正确表达动作发生在过去。

【句式表达建议】删除left

【纠错依据】原句中使用了"with", 但在这里需要表达的是"留下"的意思, 应该使用现在分词"leaving"来表示伴随或结果。因此, 将"with"改为"leaving", 使句子表达更准确。原句中"left"的位置不当, 导致句子结构混乱。将"left"移至句末, 放在"Nate's"之后, 使句子结构清晰, 表达明确。

【介词错误】by → for
【冠词错误】删除the
【纠错依据】这里应使用介词"for"来表示原因或目的, 表达"因为发现了隐藏的美"。原句中的"by"通常表示方式或手段, 不符合此处的语境。在表达"normal life"时, "normal"作为形容词修饰"life", 不需要加定冠词"the"。去掉"the"使表达更加地道和准确。

13. From this painting, Nate realized that beauty was everywhere, it ~~will~~ **would** appear when ~~you give your~~ **he gave his** heart to ~~the~~ life.
【时态错误】will → would
【代词错误,时态错误】you give your → he gave his
【冠词错误】删除the
【纠错依据】前一句使用了过去时"was", 因此后一句也应保持时态一致, 将"will"改为过去式"would", 表示过去将来时。前文主语是"Nate", 为了保持人称一致, "you"应改为"he"。为了与前文的过去时态保持一致, "give"应改为过去式"gave"。为了与主语"he"保持一致, "your"应改为"his"。此处"life"表示抽象概念, 不特指, 前面不需要加定冠词"the"。
